# BACKGROUND

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur, is recognized as the “Centre of Excellence” of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India for Tribal Health. Through a research grant from the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, AIIMS, Jodhpur has established a “Satellite Tribal Centre” at Janjatiya Bhavan located in the Abu Road block of an aspirational district, Sirohi, which is also partially tribal. The centre is engaged in recording and reporting local health problems (particularly maternal & infant health, tuberculosis, sickle cell disease, cervical cancer, etc.) among tribals, documenting the practices of tribal healers. Also, engaged in mapping of traditional tribal healers and documenting their healing practices in district Sirohi, Rajasthan.

Satellite Tribal Centre aims to improve the health conditions of tribal people by reinforcing existing healthcare services and spreading health education & health promotion for disease prevention. This centre is a unique centre in the country for health research on tribal in a participatory ecosystem where tribal people play a significant role in navigating their own health issues as stakeholders in the system.







# OBJECTIVES

To expose postgraduates to various health issues of tribal in the region with the opportunities to deliver optimal care under limited resources.

To expose postgraduates to Telemedicine and technology in healthcare delivery.

To enhance skill in System-Based Practices of Post Graduates as part of Competency-Based Medical Education.

To orient postgraduates towards promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative services being provided by various categories of healthcare professionals under the National Health Mission.

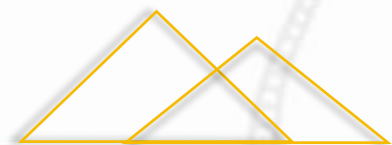
To prepare postgraduates to undertake research to strengthen healthcare delivery in underserved areas.





# IMPLEMENTATION

- All postgraduates pursuing MD/MS/MDS in broad specialties at AIIMS Jodhpur will undergo a one-week residential rotation at Satellite Tribal Centre, Abu Road.
- During this rotation, the Trainee Resident doctor will be posted at CHC Abu Road (District Health System) and various other tribal areas, including at Sub-Centre/ Ayushman Arogya Mandir, etc., in district Sirohi. The clinical responsibilities include learning under supervision in outpatient, inpatient, casualty and other areas pertaining to their speciality during the OPD hours.
- Medical & Health Department, Sirohi will provide access to the Out-Patient Department, In-Patient Department, Laboratory services available at CHC Abu Road and basic facilities for them to learn, explore and handhold in a conducive environment.
- Postgraduates of specialties where direct patient care is not involved may be involved under supervision in and contribute to the diagnostic/laboratory services, pharmacy services, forensic services, general clinical duties, managerial roles, public health programs, etc., as applicable.
- Postgraduates would remain in contact with their designated post-graduate teachers and departments at AIIMS Jodhpur for guidance, learning, and for being able to participate remotely in scheduled Case Discussions, Seminars, Journal clubs, thesis discussions, etc. and other Institutional academic activities (CPC/CGR).
- Stipend and Leaves during rotation will be under the administrative control of AIIMS Jodhpur.
- The CHC In-charge/ Faculty In-charge Satellite Tribal Centre, AIIMS Jodhpur will maintain a record of attendance at CHC Abu Road.
